South Congress Parking Strategy draft recommendations and survey now available

Austin Transportation, in partnership with the Downtown Austin Alliance and local stakeholders, continues to move forward on a comprehensive solution to address parking challenges in the South Congress neighborhood.

A <u>series of videos</u> detailing work to date and the draft recommendations is now available online. A brief <u>post-video survey</u> is also available to receive comments, questions and feedback on the recommendations.

The videos outline short-term, actionable solutions to address the parking issues on South Congress and in its adjacent neighborhoods and provide a long-term framework to improve mobility in the area.

The project team has collected, analyzed and documented detailed data about how parking is managed and used in South Congress today to better understand the parking challenges. In the study, data was collected on parking inventory, occupancy, turnover, parking and travel behavior, and local knowledge of South Congress parking challenges.
