This is an update regarding the Special Event Parking Program that when implemented will affect our neighborhood during major special events held near the Bouldin and Zilker neighborhoods. On July 13th the Austin Transportation Department hosted an open house that offered residents an opportunity to comment on the proposed Special Event Parking Program. Several persons attended the open house, reviewed two options and made comment on the Draft Parking Program.

Next Steps

ATD will finalize a plan and seek Council approval (e.g., on necessary City Code amendments and fee updates), prior to implementing an initial roll-out. Following an initial roll-out phase ATD will also pursue using this program to address parking spillover in neighborhoods resulting from nearby construction projects, as outlined in previous Council direction, detailed

below.
